

2020 Summer School and Workshops Frequently Asked Questions

Q: When are 2020 Summer School and Workshops?

Dates and times vary by type of course. Please refer to <u>Summer Programs 2020</u> for specifics. Key dates include:

- Laptop Pick Up: June 1, 10:00-2:00
- Summer School New Student Virtual Orientation and Laptop Training June 4, 2020
- Online Class dates: Session I June 4 or 5 June 25; Session II July 20 August 7
- Online June Workshops: Week 1 June 8-12, Week 2 June 15-19, Week 3 June 22-26
- Back-to-school Workshops: August 3-6

Q: What courses are offered?

A variety of .5 credit courses, non-credit Workshops are offered in the summer. Full course descriptions may be found by clicking on the tab "Summer School & Workshops" on the <u>Summer School page of the Ursuline website.</u>

Q. What are UA Essentials?

UA Essentials are a series of non-credit Workshops especially for incoming students to build skills, fill curriculum gaps, and get acclimated on campus.

Q: How do I register and pay for UA Essentials or other Workshops?

You may register and pay for Workshops directly through a parents MyBackpack account by selecting *Summer/Programs Registration*. Registration will close 3 weeks prior to each Workshop's opening day.

Q: How do I request and pay for Summer School courses?

Course Requests for Summer I credit courses are now closed. Summer II Wellness courses may be requested by emailing <u>summerschool@ursulinedallas.org</u>. Tuition for Summer School courses is applied to your tuition account.

Q. What is the attendance policy in Summer School courses?

All online classes have daily synchronous online class meetings and independent work time. Attendance is taken at the beginning of each class meeting. Late arrivals to and early departures from class meetings count as a .5 absence. Due to the abbreviated schedule, absences are limited to 2 per credit course. Any combination of missed class time totaling over 2 absences will result in a loss of credit for the class.

Q. What if I need to drop or change a Summer School Course or Workshop?

Summer School Session 1 courses may be added, dropped, or changed until June 1, 2020. Session II courses may be added, dropped, or changed until July 15, 2020. Fees for courses dropped on or after the first class day will not be refunded. To make changes a parent must email the request to <u>summerschool@ursulinedallas.org</u>.

Q: Is there a discipline policy?

Summer School 2020 will follow Ursuline's Student Code of Conduct and the Honor Code, as detailed in the Summer 2020 Student Online Course Agreement. This document must be signed by students and parents, and be turned in digitally in the student's first Summer class.
