Program	Purpose	Details
Summer School credit courses	A one-semester Ursuline course in an accelerated format to get a jump start on high school.	.5 credits per class 9:00 – 12:00 or 12:45 – 3:45 15 days June 5 - 25
Workshops	Designed with new students in mind, Workshops help students acclimate, sharpen skills, and fill gaps in curriculum. They will meet teachers, make new friends and feel confident when school begins in August!	non-credit mornings or afternoons 4 – 15 days June and August
Camps	Campers can try a new sport, or master fundamentals and improve their overall game through instruction, drills, and games. Campers will have fun and build skills needed to be a more consistent and effective athlete.	2-3 hours per day 4 days June, July and August
